Tournament Rules

Current RFU rules apply as for the U18 version of the game

The Tournament will be conducted entirely under the control of The Tournament Referee (Mr Mike Bayly) who will adjudicate on all matters where necessary.

Players must be in full time education, a registered pupil within your school and 18 or under between the dates of 1st September 2022 and 31st December 2023.

Tournament Format

The competition will initially be played in groups on a league basis. Each team will play each of the other schools competing in their group. Three points will be awarded for a win and one for a draw.

Knockout Competition: Both group winners and runners up proceed to Cup competition Semi Finals. Third and fourth placed teams proceed to Plate competition Semi-Finals. The team finishing fifth and sixth proceed to the Bowl competition semi-finals.

Competition Rules

1. Squads of 14 players. 12 players should be selected for day 1, two of whom may be replaced on day 2 irrespective of injury. Selection of 12 players for each day should be submitted to Tournament Referee before teams first KO of the day.

2. The Pool placings will be determined by the greatest number of Pool points won.

3 points for a win

2 points for a draw

1 point for 4 tries and more

1 point for a loss within and including 7 points

0 for a loss

· If there is a tie in points scored in Pool, the result will be decided by:

- a. Points difference
- b. Result of the game between the two tied sides
- c. Number of Tries scored
- d. Number of Wins
- e. Toss of a coin

Playing Rules

3. Playing time will not usually exceed 42 minutes (3 games) in any two-hour period.
4. Games will be played under the World Rugby Laws, U19 variations for Rugby 7s.
5. Each item of protective clothing, padding or otherwise, must conform to IRB Laws
6. Each game shall be played for 7 minutes each way.
7. No extra time will be played in the pool rounds and matches will be left drawn
8. In the knock-out rounds (except for Cup Final) if, at the end of normal time, neither side has won, the team that scored last in the match to earn the draw, wins. If the score is 0 all, the team with the following criteria wins; 1. Most tries in tournament, 2. Least tries against, 3. Wins a coin toss (In the case of the Plate and Bowl Finals, no coin toss will take place and the teams would share the trophy).

In the Cup Final, teams will play an extra time 'sudden death' period of five minutes with the first side to score being declared the winner. If, no points were scored in this period, then the winner would be declared by 1. Having scored most tries in tournament, 2. Least tries against. If still tied, then the Cup will be shared.

9. Rolling substitutions can be made with the referee's permission and be made only when there is a stoppage or the ball is out of play.
10. The use of Temporary Suspension (Sin Bin) for receiving a yellow card will be used for 2 minutes of the playing time.
11. Any player receiving a red card for an offence in a match will have a minimum one match ban, however it is open to appeal through the tournament organisers.

From the South via M1

Leave the motorway at junction 17 (for Coventry M45). At the first roundabout [M45/A45 junction] take the second exit for Dunchurch, then follow the directions **From Both Routes below...**

From the South West

Access the A45 in the south of Coventry area, and follow directions as above, but taking the first exit, then follow the directions **From Both Routes below...**

From Both Routes

Continue into Dunchurch, just over a mile, and turn left at the traffic lights in the village centre. Continue out of Dunchurch until the roundabout and take the second exit [for Northampton, M1 and Hillmorton].

Continue about a mile until a minor crossroads by the speed camera and turn left here [Rugby and St Cross] into Barby Road. You will pass the School polo fields, Springhill playing fields and Hospital all on your right, before climbing up a small incline. You will then see School buildings on your left and right. The Close is on the left.

Air & Rail Links

By Rail: Rugby is situated on the main West Coast line from Euston with a frequent fast service from London which takes only 48 minutes.

By Air: Motorway links provide easy access to East Midland, Birmingham, London, Luton and Stanstead airports.

From the North via M1

Leave the motorway at junction 20, Lutterworth, and take the third exit for the A426 [Rugby]; you cross the A5 then pass junction 1 of the M6, then follow the directions **From All Three Routes below...**

From the North via M6

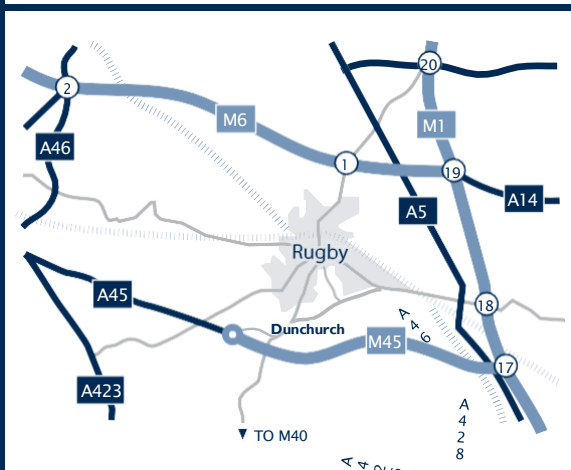
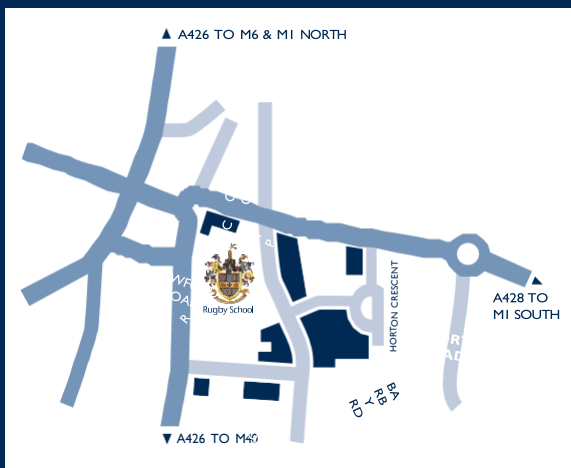
Leave the motorway at junction 1, take the third exit on to the A426 [Rugby], then follow the directions **From All Three Routes below...**

From the A14, continue on to the M6 (West), turn off at junction 1 and take the first exit onto the A426 for Rugby, then follow the directions **From All Three Routes below...**

Continue on the A426 over the next three roundabouts until reaching the fourth with Tesco to the left. Continue straight on, through traffic lights, then take the first exit at the following roundabout [Town Centre and St Cross]. Continue to the next roundabout and take the second exit (straight on) into Corporation Street (Dual carriageway), straight through the traffic lights at Asda and turn left at the next set of traffic lights [Webb Ellis public house on left]. Keep in the left hand lane which guides you past the School on the right. Take the first right into Barby Road [St Cross Hospital] and The Close is to the right.
